

GALLATIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
November 22, 2021
Special Meeting

The Special Meeting of the Gallatin County Fiscal Court was called to order by Judge Ryan Morris on November 22, 2021 at 6:00 p.m. at the Gallatin County Senior Center, Warsaw, Kentucky. Magistrates present were Ethan Moore, Donnie Sullivan, Joel Shinkle and M. J Haddix. County Attorney John G. Wright was also present. Everyone stood for the pledge of allegiance.

Judge Morris explained that this was a special meeting and only those items on the agenda may be discussed and voted on.

Judge Morris stated that for an emergency ordinance to be considered valid after one reading, ***KRS 67.078 (2) states that a majority of the fiscal court may declare an emergency to exist by naming and describing the emergency, and thereafter may adopt a county ordinance to address that emergency without regard to the requirements of KRS 67.077.***

Knox Lillard Emergency Road Ordinance

Judge Morris then described the emergency that existed on Knox Lillard Road in regard to Truck Traffic and the safety factors associated with that traffic on a county road. Judge Morris made the motion that an emergency existed on Knox Lillard Road. Magistrate MJ Haddix seconded the motion. No further discussion occurred, and the motion passed with all Ayes.

County Attorney John Wright read the Emergency Ordinance out loud. Magistrate Ethan Moore made a motion to accept the Emergency Ordinance. Magistrate Joel Shinkle seconded the motion. No Further discussion occurred and the motion passed with all Ayes.
